DID YOU KNOW?

This ant is known as the Argentine ant.

It's 1/8-inch in length and its color varies from dark brown to black.

Argentine ant colonies can grow quite large and contain tens of thousands of workers and hundreds of queens.

Each colony is divided into subcolonies that usually extend over several properties.

This makes one huge super-colony!

Argentine ants are aggressive and will drive out native species of ants creating an environment where they are "queen" of the hill.

Their primary food source during the warm months is the sweet honeydew produced by aphids and mealybugs.
