DID YOU KNOW?

The spider below is a yellow sac spider, and is known for resting in a small silken retreat, or sac, during the day.

It is about 1/4-inch in size, and in real life, it is a pale yellowish green color.

A nighttime hunter, the yellow sac spider feeds on small insects and sometimes other spiders!

This spider likely accounts for more bites to people than any spider in the U.S. Fortunately, the venom has little effect.

Not all spiders bite people, but it is a good idea to leave them alone just in case.
